

ASK KATHY QUESTIONS

1) When will pink slips from the District be delivered and who will be making the deliveries? In the past, John Rogers had done this with the principals. *Thirty-one slips will be delivered; all are temporary. No probationary teachers will be receiving one. Kathy Hannemen will be delivering them, along with the principals, to AHJS, FAA, Creston, Carissa Plains, Rolfe will be delivering slips to SM, SB, MR, SRA, Kim Spinks will deliver the high school slips. This will begin the week of March 10, and all will be hand-delivered by March 14. Contracts will begin to be re-offered in May, but they will not be finalized until August.*

2) San Gabriel after-school meetings are consistently running until 4:30-4:45 twice a month. The contract states that "...to endeavor to limit the number to approximately one such meeting..." (p. 19) What is the best way to address this issue with the principal? *Chris Balough San Gabriel had 2 meetings in Sept., 2 meetings in October, one in November, one in December, 2 in January, and 0 in February. Kathy Hanneman will put this on the next Principals' Meeting to make sure all principals are aware of the contract.*
